Prayer requests may be submitted on the cards in the back of the pews.

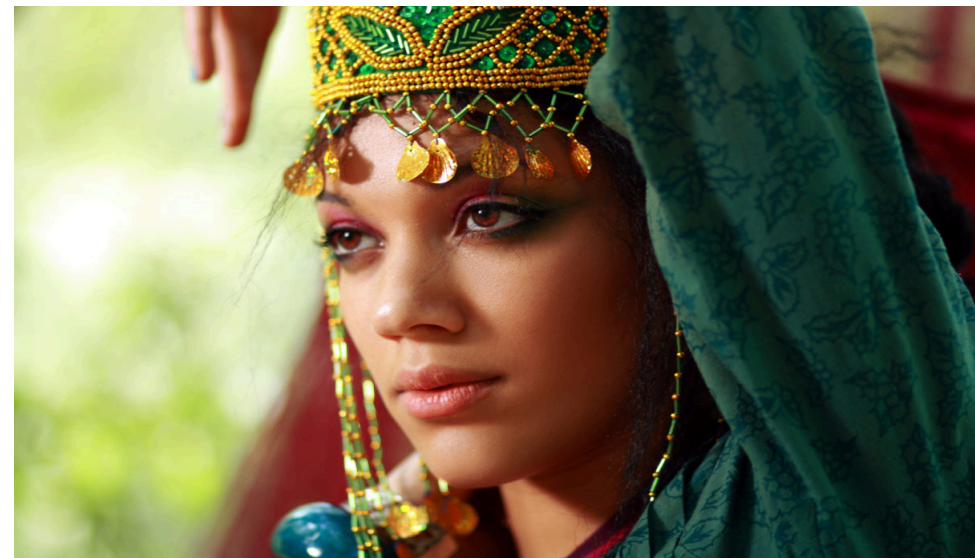
